

GHOSTLINE V

Requirements

- Script Hook V
- ScriptHookVDotNet-nightly v3.7.0-nightly.175 or newer

Installation

1. Install Script Hook V and ScriptHookVDotNet-nightly.
2. Copy `GHOSTLINE V.dll` and `GHOSTLINE V.ini` into your `GTA V\scripts` folder.
3. (Optional) Place your own exported alarm `.wav` files into `GTA V\scripts\GHOSTLINE V\Audio\`
4. Launch GTA V in Story Mode.
5. Press F5 in-game to open GHOSTLINE V.

Controls

- F5 - Open / Close GHOSTLINE V
- E - Connect to the locked target
- Enter - Confirm selection
 - Open Chaos Events when no target is locked
- W / S - Navigate the menu
- Backspace - Go back / Close menu

All controls can be changed in `GHOSTLINE V.ini` under the `[Controls]` section.

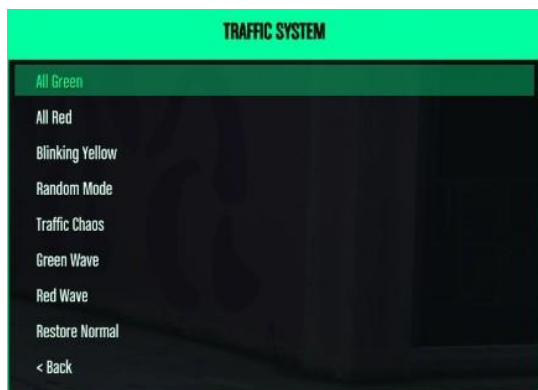
Police Vehicle

- False Wanted



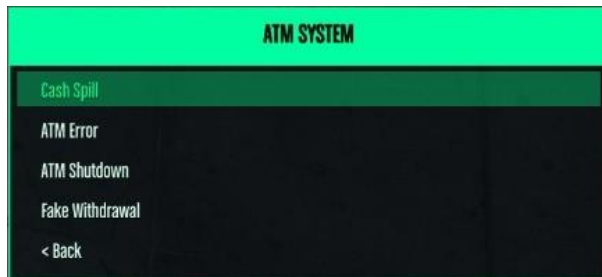
Traffic Light

- Red Wave



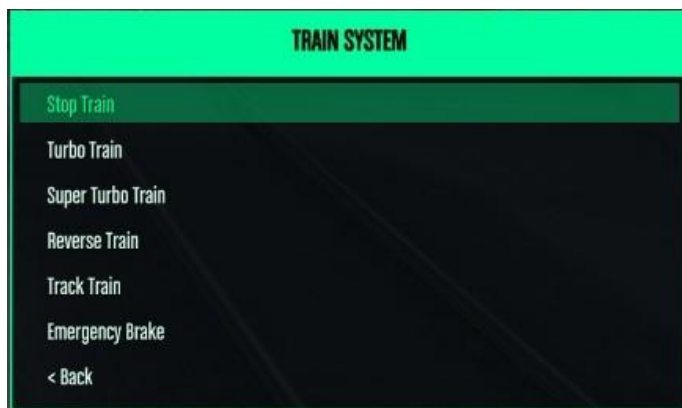
ATM

- Cash Spill (drops real cash piles and attracts nearby NPCs)
- ATM Error
- ATM Shutdown (dispatches two rifle-armed police officers to the ATM)
- Fake Withdrawal



Train

- Stop
- Turbo
- Super Turbo
- Reverse
- Track
- Emergency Brake



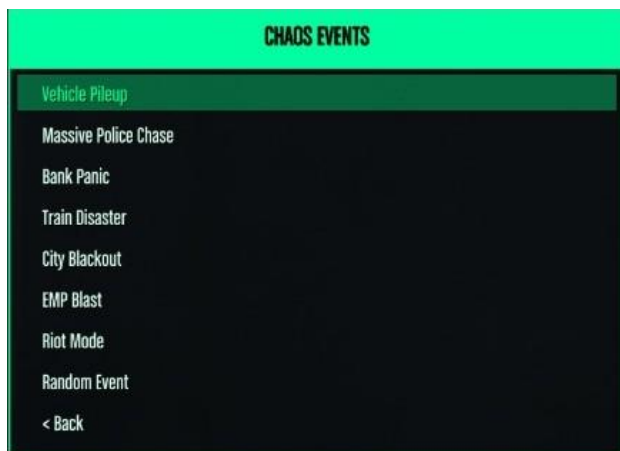
Power Grid

- Blackout District
- Restore Power
- Overload (explosion, panic, and alarm)
- Alarm Network
- Camera Network



Chaos Events (No Target Required)

- Pileup
- Massive Police Chase
- Bank Panic
- Train Disaster
- City Blackout
- EMP Blast
- Riot Mode
- Random Event



Notes

- Spawned police units and pursuit vehicles automatically despawn after roughly 3 minutes once they are off-screen.
- False Flag and Massive Police Chase units actively pursue the target and eventually ram or PIT the vehicle if the chase continues.
- Chaos Events, Fake Dispatch, and False Flag spawn real NPCs and vehicles, so a small performance drop may occur in crowded areas.

- Alarm-related hacks (Overload, ATM Error, Bank Panic, Riot Mode) will play a random `.wav` file from `GHOSTLINE V\Audio\` if any are present. Otherwise, a built-in alarm sound is used.
- When reporting bugs, include what you were doing and attach your `GHOSTLINE V.ini` configuration if possible.
